Loretto High School is a special place — one where students are encouraged to learn and teachers try to make the learning fun.

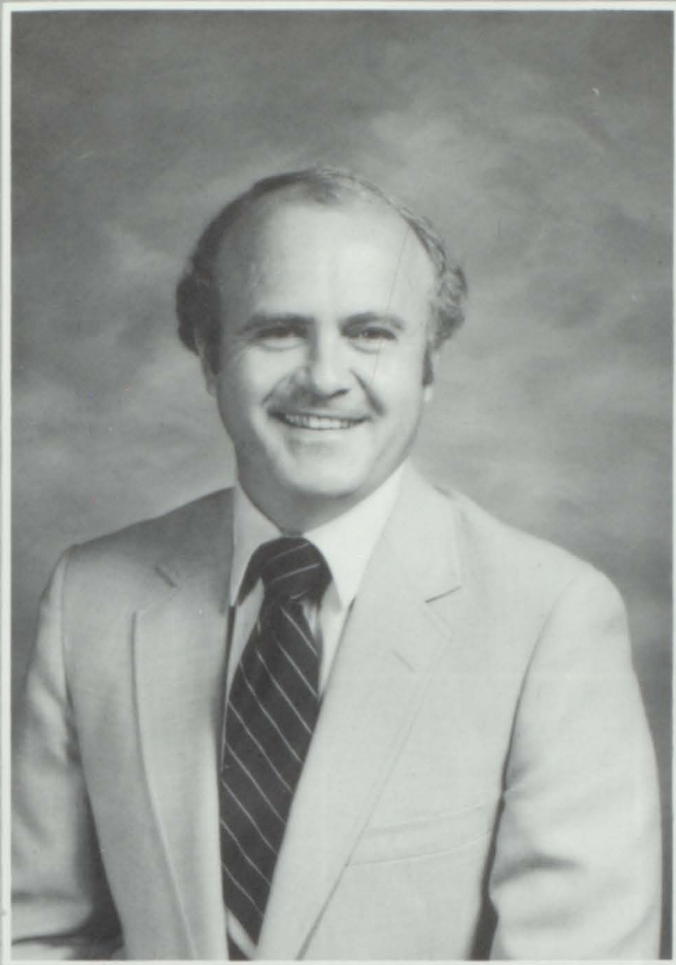

# Mr. And Miss LHS

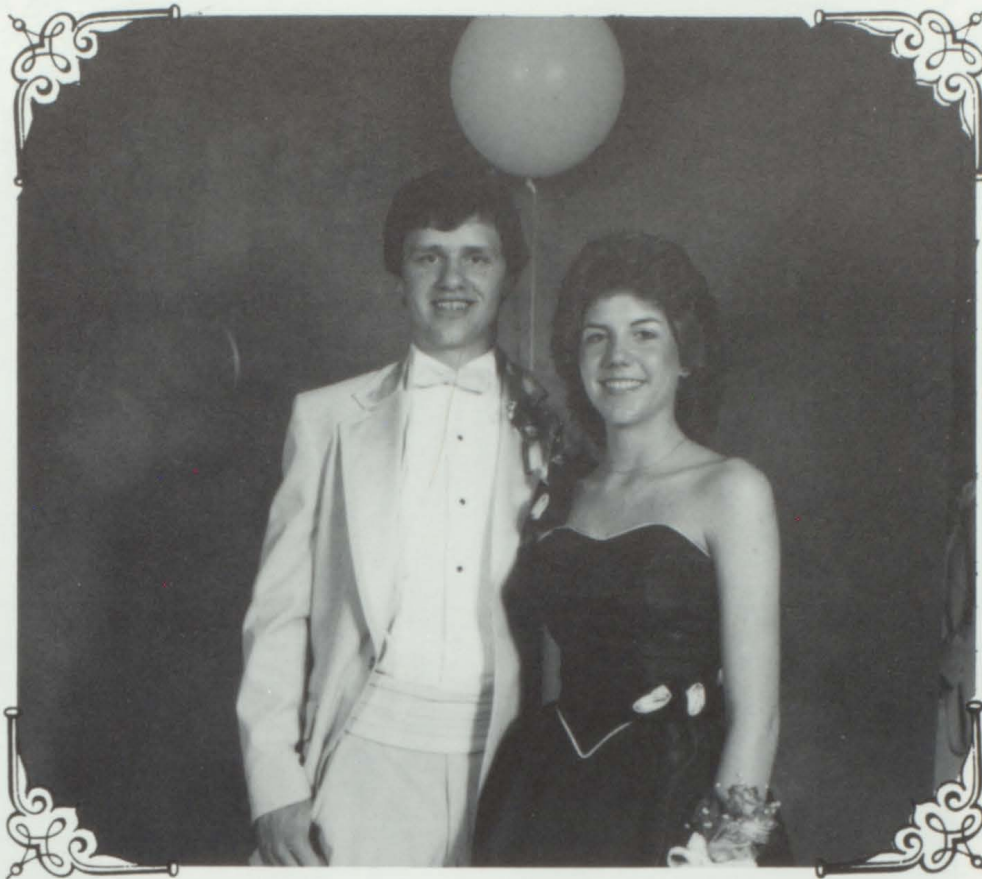
